Campers can look forward to lots of fun this summer in Cooking with Lily and Emily! Our recipe of the week is something lots of kids have eaten but not made themselves!

Caesar Dressing

- Mince one can anchovy fillets (drained) and 2 garlic cloves, mix together.
- In a separate bowl, whisk 3 egg yolks, then whisk in one tsp Dijon mustard.
- Whisk in the anchovy-garlic mixture.
- While whisking, add in 2 tbs. lemon juice.
- Whisk in 2 tbs. olive oil, and continue whisking until it thickens.
- Continue whisking and slowly add ½ cup vegetable oil. Once added, continue whisking to thicken.
- Mix in 2 tbs. grated parmesan cheese, and season to taste with black pepper.
