The Recipe of the Week is for **Oatmeal Cups with Yogurt**

Mix together:

| 1 ¼ cups quick oats            | 2 tablespoons honey |
| 1 teaspoon cinnamon            | 1/8 teaspoon salt   |
| 1/4 cup unsweetened applesauce |                     |

Mix together ingredients and press firmly into 6 muffin tins with liners to create bowl shapes. Bake at 350 for 12 minutes. Cool 10 minutes, then fill with yogurt and berries!
