## Notes for Home!

Follow us on Facebook (LakeView Day Camp) and Instagram (LVDCthinksummer) for updates all summer long – and be sure to tag us in your camp posts!

- PLEASE have your camper ready at their scheduled morning bus pickup time, preferably waiting outside, as a courtesy to other camp families. We allocate just a few minutes for your camper to give you a quick goodbye hug and hop onto the bus to get buckled in. When a camper isn't ready when the bus arrives, it slows down the route. We don't want our campers to miss even a minute of LakeView fun!
- If you receive a missed call from camp during the day, please be sure to check your voicemail before you call us back if you can. There are lots of reasons we might be calling you - to ask a question, tell you about something fantastic your camper did, or to follow up with you. And there are many different people who could be calling you; we only know where to direct your call if you've checked to see whose call you're returning.
- Please be sure to check your texts from Remind when you receive them. We periodically send information, messages and permission slips for overnights and other activities, and this is the best way to get things to you during the summer!

If you need to pick up your camper early, please be sure to *notify the office in advance*, via bus mail, email to transportation@lakeviewdaycamp.com or a phone call at 732-821-8933, so we can have them ready to go!
