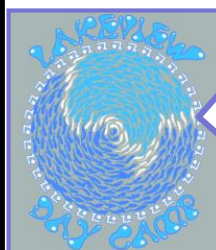
LakeView Camper Overnights

What’s Cooking in Cooking This week’s recipe is for UNICORN FUDGE!

- Line an 8x8” pan with parchment paper
- Place 24 oz. white chocolate chips, ½ cup heavy cream, and ½ tsp. vanilla extract into a microwave safe bowl and melt in 30-second intervals until smooth.
- Add a few drops of purple food coloring and mix (add more until you get the desired color)
- Pour into prepared pan and smooth with knife or spatula
- Add sprinkles and press lightly into fudge
- Cool in refrigerator for an hour and cut into squares before serving at room temperature
